An Agency Fund is a type of Designated Fund that is created by the nonprofit for its own benefit. Many of the highly respected organizations throughout our region establish their endowments with Inland Northwest Community Foundation so their own staff is freed up to focus on their mission. Endowed Agency Funds make charitable distributions to the organization to support their general charitable purposes or a specific activity as defined by its board of directors.
