Community Strategies Grant Program Open for Applicants

SPOKANE, WA, 12.15.10—Inland Northwest Community Foundation (INWCF) is accepting applications for the Community Strategies Grant Program (CSGP). The application period begins on December 13, 2010 and ends on January 25, 2011. Applications must be submitted online at www.inwcf.org.

The Community Strategies Grant Program supports projects and programs related to arts and culture, education, environmental preservation, community/economic development and human services. Grant amounts typically are between \$10,000 and \$30,000. More than \$732,000 in funding was awarded through this grant program in the past year.

The Community Strategies Grant Program is open to all eligible nonprofit organizations in the 20-counties the Foundation serves. This is the second round of CSGP grant applications in INWCF's 2011 fiscal year. Nonprofits that did not apply in round one are eligible to apply for the second round.
