Our new site provides support and information to help our donors, friends and nonprofit organizations answer their most common questions. The Web site also helps nonprofits grow their funds.

For example, Every Woman Can® Foundation, established a fund with INWCF in January and received three online gifts shortly thereafter. Inland Imaging created this fund to help nonprofit healthcare organizations pay for annual mammography and breast cancer treatment for women who are uninsured or unable to pay for screening, treatment, counseling and education.

The ability to make contributions online is just one great enhancement. The Web site has also been redesigned with a fresh new look, easy navigation and has been updated with information about how your community foundation puts charitable dollars to work for you.

Some of the newest Web site features include:
